



Terms and conditions for fishing on Finnmark Estate

Fishermen are obliged to read the prevailing provisions in the legislation relating to salmon and inland fishing, relevant regulations and regulations set by the landowner.

1) General provisions

a. Scope of the fishing licence

The fishing licence is valid for fishing all species of inland fish, with the exception of anadromous fish (salmon, sea trout and sea char). In watercourses with anadromous fish, the provisions stipulated for anadromous species also apply to inland fish.

b. Disinfection of fishing tackle

Fishing tackle, boats and other objects that may carry infection must be dried or disinfected before being moved to other watercourses or other parts of the same watercourse.

c. Using fish as bait

It is not permitted to use live fish as bait. It is permitted to use dead fish from the same watercourse as bait.

d. The Pasvik River

Separate regulations apply to fishing in the Pasvik River.

e. Pikefossen fishing area (Kautokeino river, Lahpojohka and Masijohka)

Pikefossen fishing area is defined as a separate fishing zone and require a specific fishing licence. The Pikefossen fishing area licence is not valid for the rest of Finnmarkseiendommen. The licence for Finnmarkseiendommen is not valid in the Pikefossen fishing area.

2) Fishing licence

a. Residents in Finnmark

Residents of Finnmark can fish inland fish free of charge. Registration of a free fishing licence is optional.

b. Residents outside of Finnmark

All persons resident outside of Finnmark require a fishing licence, with the exception of:

- Persons studying in Finnmark
- Persons serving military service in Finnmark
- Refugees with temporary residence status in Finnmark

Fishermen must always bring their fishing licence when fishing, and present it if controlled.

c. Fishermen aged 16 to 20

Visiting fishermen aged 16 to 20 may fish free of charge, although a fishing licence is still required. To register a free fishing licence for youth, please visit: www.natureit.no.

d. Activation of fishing licence

- Activate your fishing licence before you start fishing. Activate your licence for the fishing zone where you plan to fish.
- Day licences are activated when purchased.
- Seasonal licences are not activated when purchased, and have to be activated before you start fishing. Activate your licence by the app Natureit, on www.natureit.no or by sending the following SMS: fefofiske <fishing zone> to

1963 (e.g. "fefofiske SVA51" to 1963).

- Even if you have activated your licence for one fishing zone, the fishing licence is valid for the entire Finnmark Estate (except Pikefossen fishing area). If you have been fishing in a different fishing zone than the zone you specified upon activation, you can change this when you submit your catch report.

e. Catch report

Submit your catch report at www.natureit.no.

3) Fishing regulations

Persons resident outside of Finnmark are permitted to fish with rod, otter board and hand-held line. Residents of Finnmark are permitted to fish with rod, otter board, hand-held line, net and other fixed gear. Regulations for inland fishing with nets in Finnmark specify restrictions on net fishing in each municipality.

The use of rods and hand-held lines are permitted all year round. Otter boards are only permitted in lakes.

4) Violation of terms

A violation of these terms may result in immediate confiscation of fishing licence and/or a police report.
